THE WORD

Bible Reading (dramatised)

Luke 6. 17-26

Two volunteers who sit on different sides of the congregation with a large card – one saying 'Blessed' and the other 'Woe'.

Narrator:

Jesus came down from the mountain and stood on the plain, with a great crowd of his disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea, Jerusalem, and the coast of Tyre and Sidon. They had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases: and those who were troubled with unclean spirits were cured. And all in the crowd were trying to touch Jesus, for power came out from him and healed all of them. Then Jesus looked up at his disciples and said:

Jesus moves to centre stage; as he begins to speak, the volunteer with the 'Blessed' card stands up, holds up the card, and turns slowly through 360° so that all can see it.

Jesus:

Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you will be filled. Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh. Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you on account of the Son of Man. Rejoice on that day and leap for joy, for surely your reward is great in heaven; for that is what their ancestors did to the prophets. The first volunteer sits down. The second volunteer stands up holds up the 'Woe' card, and turns slowly through 360° as Jesus speaks.

Jesus:

But woe to you who are rich, for you have received your consolation. Woe to you who are full now, for you will be hungry.
Woe to you who are laughing now, for you will mourn and weep.
Woe to you when all speak well of you, for that is what their ancestors did to

the false prophets.

This is the word of the Lord **Thanks be to God.**
