Let us affirm our faith in Jesus Christ the Son of God.

The Creed

All We believe in one God. the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth; of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. God of love, we pray for ourselves. Awaken in us compassion and humility as we seek and serve Christ in all people. Help us to be instruments of reconciliation in our world and use us for the work of your kingdom. Lord, in your mercy,

All hear our prayer.

Merciful Father, *All* accept these prayers for the sake of your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.
